BIRD ROAD Electric Conduit and Manhole Installation Road Closure

The Mansfield Municipal Electric Department (MMED) has scheduled the installation of a new electric manhole and conduit system on Bird Road. Work is being done in the public right-of-way on Bird Road from Maple Street past Mary Dee Lane at the transmission line.

Work is to begin on or about September 12 and is estimated to take approximately 3 months. This project is required in conjunction with the construction of the new East Mansfield Substation to be located next to the transmission lines on Bird Road.

A road closure will be required for this work on Bird Road. The road closure will be from 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM and traffic will be detoured as shown on the detour map posted on www.mansfieldma.com under Notices.

For families with children who ride a bus to school, for the duration of the construction project, the new bus stop will be at the corner of Maple and Bird Road. The Mansfield School Department will post pick up times and other information at www.mansfieldschools.com early during the week of August 29th. During construction a detail police officer will be available to assist those walking down Bird Road to the temporary bus stop.
