#### **Summary of Duties:**

Performs all levels of line work at voltages up to 15,000 volts during the safe and efficient construction, maintenance, and repair, of the overhead and underground electric distribution system. Works long hours as required during emergencies.

**Supervision Received:** Works under the direction of the Line Supervisor, Assistant Line Supervisor, Lead Line worker, and Lineworker 1st Class.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

**Education and Experience:** High School diploma or GED required. Entry level requires successful completion of an accredited Apprentice Line School, such as NEPPA, and at least 18 months of successful experience as an apprentice. Progression to First Class requires at least four and half year's satisfactory experience as a lower class lineman. Candidates must provide proof of educational training hours and practical work experience.

**Licenses/Certificates:** Massachusetts Class B CDL is required; Massachusetts Hoisting Engineer License with minimum 1C certification is preferred.

#### **Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:**

- Demonstrate technical skills to perform work in a safe and efficient manner.
- Possess troubleshooting skills to determine cause of system problems.
- Exhibit strong communications skills and convey a kind and courteous image to the public in both routine and emergency situations.
- Must be a self-starter as well as have a proven ability to work cooperatively in a team environment.
